Payment must be made on the day of your session via credit card, debit card, bank transfer through Pay ID (0436 20 2121) or exact cash. You will be provided with a receipt which you can use to claim a rebate from your health insurance if speech pathology is covered by your policy. NDIS participants using Plan Managers are personally liable for unpaid accounts should your NDIS plan have insufficient funds to pay. We are unable to service Agency Managed NDIS participants.

All speech pathology sessions include up to 10 minutes of oral / email reporting (non-cumulative). Additional reporting or resource generation exceeding this amount will be charged at the oral / email reporting rate in 15 minute increments. Should you require a written report a fee will be charged.

A cancellation / non-attendance fee will be charged if less than 36 hours' notice is given. There is no rebate for this fee. Non-payment of fees will result in legal proceedings against you.

Speech pathology assessment and therapy sessions, and reports relating directly to client management, are not subject to GST and the fees quoted above are GST exclusive. Reporting not directly related to client care, for example reports requested by a Court of Law, are subject to GST and GST will be added to the reporting fees quoted above.
